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#### Introduction

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# Securities Market Practice Group (SMPG)

- •SMPG was created in July 1998 and since its inception has established a local presence in more than 30 countries through National Market Practice Groups (NMPG).
- These groups are comprised of broker/dealers, investment managers, custodian banks, central securities depositories and regulators.
- •SMPG has been extremely successful in creating globally agreed harmonised market practices which, integrated with ISO standards has brought the securities industry closer to achieving Straight Through Processing (STP).
- •The SMPG is focused on enhancing the current securities industry practices.

#### SMPG Accomplishments

To date SMPG has produced a significant number of market practice recommendations within Trade Initiation/Confirmation, Settlement, Reconciliation and Corporate Actions. Additionally, SMPG has since expanded to define market practices for the Investment Funds industry.



# **SMPG Process**

- •The SMPG is open to all participants interested in creating globally agreed market practices for the securities industry.
- •This objective includes the harmonisation of non-regulated geographic differences, as well as consistent implementation by securities industry participants for processing within and across all markets.
- Monthly meetings of the NMPGs, and the 2 physical meetings per year of the SMPG as well as periodic conference calls, cover many issues also including when required the creation of NMPGs in non-participating countries or the development of multi-year project plans.



The detail process begins with the NMPGs' analysis and documentation of local practices.

# **Market Practices in Colombia**

- The Decree 1243 [14 June 2013] is a good not to say excellent driver
- National Group
  - The actors are known already
    - Asset Managers
    - CSDs
    - Commercial banks (Payments)
    - Stock Exchange
    - Central Bank
    - Clearing House
    - Custodians
- Is there a 'pain' somewhere? Manual work with too high operational risk?
- A NMPG (National Market Practice Group) requires a facilitator, who should be a SME subject matter expert. In full transparency with their employers, the members must be committed to dedicate time for a key market place project.

A NMPG is not a space for competition, but a space where technical experts find (and define) solutions in a consensual mode to harmonize / standardize their messages



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
